Winnacunnet High School is offering a summer school program to provide students opportunities to recover credit for some failed courses, or to complete competencies. Courses are offered to students to complete No Credit (NC) requirements, Incompletes (I) and to recover credit for courses failed during the school year.

Summer school will run from Monday, July 2, Tuesday, July 3. The next week it will be Monday-Friday, July 9-13. The following weeks classes will be Monday through Thursday until July 26. Classes will meet 4 days per week. Based on class enrollments, the principal may cancel undersubscribed courses. In the event that a class is cancelled, all funds will be returned. All recovery grades received in summer school classes will be counted in the student's un-weighted grade point average.

Registration payment of \$25 is due June 30. All course payments must be paid by check, money order, or cash. Recovery courses will \$100. Students may enroll in only one recovery class. NC courses and I will be billed upon completion of the NC or I at the rate of \$10 a day. It may be possible for students to complete more than one course

Recovery (E)	Attending summer school to recover credit for a course(s) failed during the school year Appropriate credits will be awarded upon successful completion of each class. Class may be taught using a computer based competency recovery program. Students must attend the entire course to complete for credit.
No Credit (NC)	Attending summer school to complete a No Credit (NC) for a course(s) during the school year. A prescription plan has been provided by the teacher. Appropriate credits will be awarded upon successful completion of each class.
Incomplete (I)	Attending summer school to complete an incomplete (I) for a course(s) during the school year. A prescription plan has been provided by the teacher. Appropriate credits will be awarded upon successful completion of each class.

All NC grades will supplant the issued NC for full credit for the course.

All I (Incomplete) grades will supplant the issued I for full credit for the course. The grade will be determined by the teacher or record and may not change until August 2018.

All grades received in recovery summer school classes will be counted in the student's un-weighted grade point average. Class sizes are limited and students will be accepted on a first come, first paid basis. Based on class enrollments, the principal may cancel undersubscribed classes. In the event that a class is cancelled, all funds will be returned.
