The preparations for the graduation ceremony for the Class of 2020 are being finalized. These plans include the public safety precautions and guidelines to provide an in-person graduation ceremony. We recognize that the health and safety of all participants is of the utmost importance. Attached is the Winnacunnet High School Class of 2020 Graduation Ceremony Clearance Attestation that all participants (graduates and guests) must sign. Please review this form carefully.

If you are at higher risk for more severe illness (older adults or those with underlying health conditions) we encourage you not to attend the graduation ceremony. Likewise, if you are uncomfortable with the risk of attending caused by COVID-19, you should not attend. The graduation ceremony will be live-streamed, as well as recorded and included as part of a video graduation presentation, to be aired on Monday, June 29, 2020.
