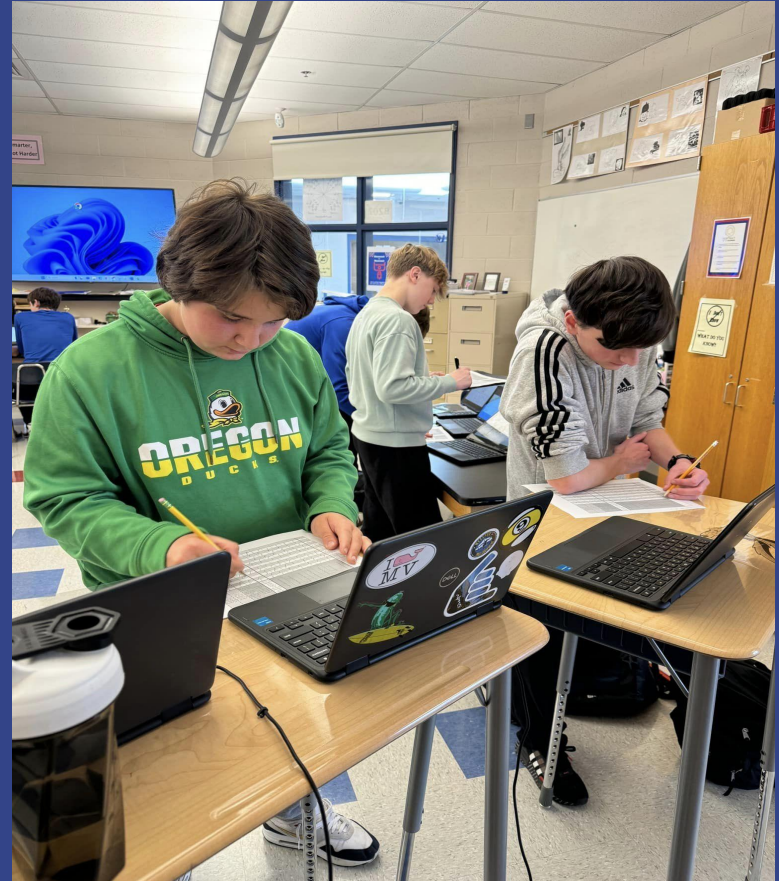

  - Courses can run one trimester, two-trimesters, or year long.

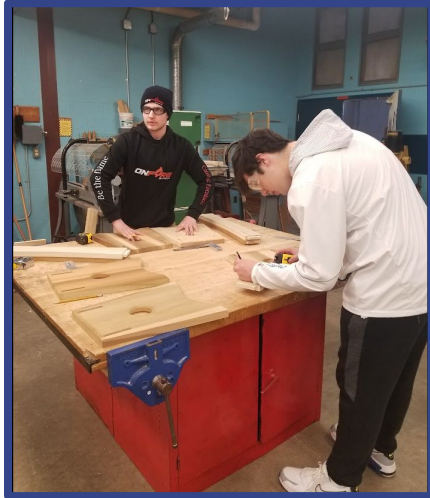

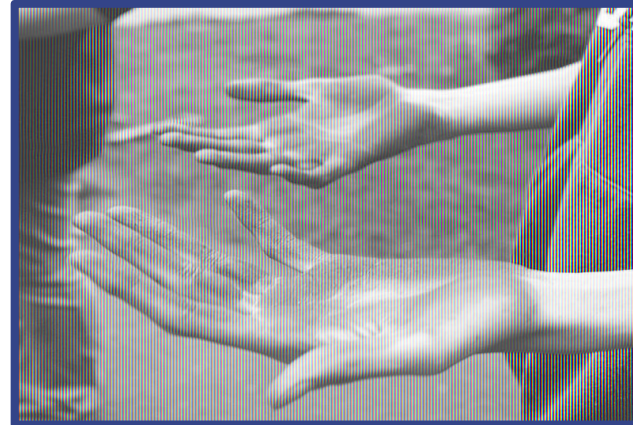

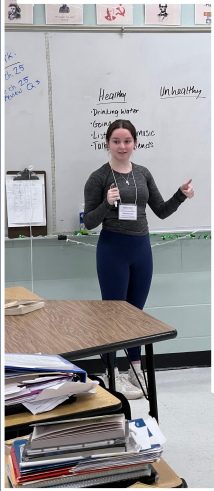
ELOs promote real world learning experiences that are driven by the students own interests, skills and abilities.

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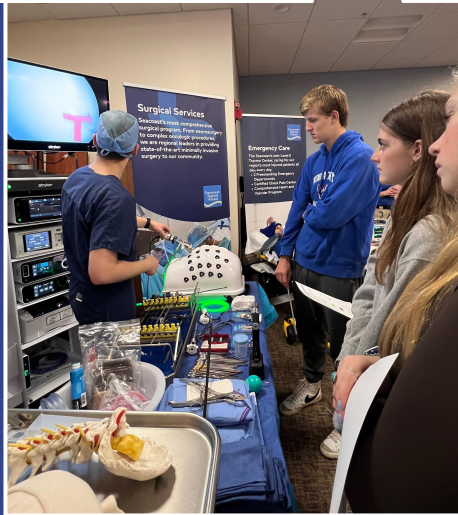
